### **Class Award vs Exams**

This is a question that we do appear to be getting more frequently and we would like to reassure you that our policies have not changed for over 30 years, however, children appear to be attending so many extra curriculum activities, poor attendance to class and educational pressures that sometimes we feel that the class award would be better for their personal sense of achievement than the exam. Every child is different and progresses differently and we feel that we know what would be best for your dancer.

We are not sure if we can blame Covid Lockdowns, but so many children are getting very anxious about doing an exam and to us it is so very important for the whole experience to be a positive and happy one.

The Class Award is still examined and they receive a report, medal and certificate the same as an exam with the only difference being the criteria is not as intense as an exam and they do not have to perform anything on their own.

The RAD syllabus is the best Ballet training in the world, however, extremely difficult and taking longer to perfect. We want for the children to progress at what we feel is a reasonable rate without getting bored and able to achieve their very best.

Exam or class award, we still make the day as special as possible for all of our dancers.

### **Examination information**

All RAD & ISTD examinations are accredited on the Qualifications framework and classed as formal qualifications.

Graded and Vocational Examinations in Dance at Level 3 have now been allocated points on the UCAS Tariff. This means that candidates who have achieved a Pass or higher in a Level 3 qualification (Grades 6, 7, 8, Intermediate and Advanced Foundation) can use their RAD & ISTD examination result towards their points tariff when applying to University or a Higher Education institution in the UK.

# Outstanding fees

Can we please ask that the end of this current half term pay all outstanding fees. We currently have over 40% of families with outstanding fees and with the increase in both rent and utility bills; we cannot afford to have outstanding fees. As this problem is getting worse, we have implemented a new rule that anyone with outstanding fees will not be entered for exams, competitions or special events within the school. We believe in giving every child a chance to dance, therefore, please contact us if you wish to set up a payment plan.

## Terms & Conditions

Can we please remind you of the 'Terms & Conditions' that are signed when joining the school and in particular to the notice period upon leaving.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

A full terms invoice will be issued before the start of each term and fees must be paid by the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of the new term.

Fees will not be refunded in cases of absence.

A half term written notice is required when leaving the school. Pupils can still attend during their notice period and undertake any examinations etc that might be due.

If you have more than one child attending the school or a child that attends multiple lessons, then we are happy to receive 2 payments.

A £10 administration fee will be charged for late payment.

Unless you state otherwise, you give full permission for photos/videos to be taken at events and can then be used for all media associated with The Rhodes Academy of Dance.

As we return to a new Dancing year, can we please ask that all dancers wear the regulation uniform to class and all younger dancers do not wear Ballet dressing up outfits? Hair should be in an immaculate Bun for all classes. As a school we have always had pride in our dancers appearance and it is so important for the discipline of dance.

Ballet shoes ... are designed to support a dancers young foot, therefore, please do not buy shoes from Amazon, Wish, H&M or any other supplier that is not a professional dance shop.

## **General Requests**

Below are the usual beneficial points that I include in newsletters; however, I feel that there are still a handful of parents that do not follow the rules in our school. If it is a 'Daddy' day and Dad is unable to put your daughters hair in a bun, please bring the pins and bun net and we will do the bun for you. If your daughter arrives to class in 'non' uniform accessories they will be asked to remove them.

**Dance shoes** - Can you please NOT allow your children to wear any dance shoes outside! This ruins the sole of ballet and character shoes and scratches the taps on tap shoes, which will ruin the very expensive purpose flooring in the studios! If they are seen doing this, they will be asked to remove their shoes for class.

Ascot House Studios – ONLY Park in the correct allocated spaces. Please park in spaces marked The Heidi Rhodes School of Dancing ONLY! This includes WEEKENDS as our neighbour's work at weekends too!

All Locations of the school - Can I please ask that you continue to watch your children and do not allow them to run around and climb on furniture and window ledges! For those of you that have been with us for a long time, you will know how much we have fought for all of our premises and I would like to keep them pristine, clean and above all else - safe! Can I please ask that you are sensitive to other users of halls/churches when changing your children in and out of dancewear? Please clear up dropped food/drinks as children step in this and ruin their Ballet shoes.
